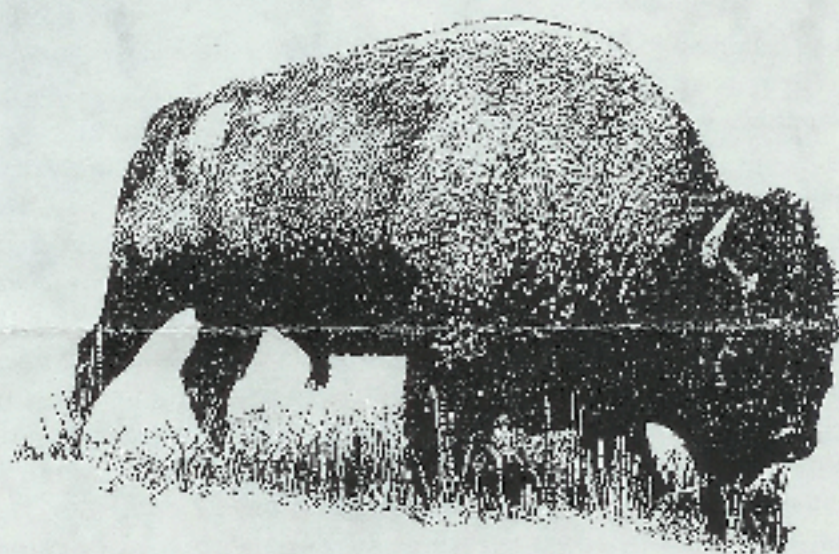


## In Tribute To, Constance Lewis
